Title IX Notice of Nondiscrimination Summer & Fall 2024

<u>Title IX</u> of the Education Amendments of 1972, 20 U.S.C. § 1681 et seq., and its implementing regulation, 34 C.F.R. Part 106 (Title IX) prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexin education programs or activities operated by recipients of Federal financial assistance. Title IX states that No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sexbe excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under anyeducational program or activity eceiing federal assistance."

Title IX and the Student Policy Prohibiting Sexal Misconduct and Discrimination in the Academic/ Educational Enironment prohibit, for example:

- Treating individuals differently because of their sexgender
- Creating a hostile enironment for individuals because of their sexgender
- Coercing another individual for a sexal relationship
- Failing to seek mutual consent for sexal active

The Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) crimes of stalking, domestic iølence, and dating iølence mayalso fall under sexoffenses if the underling offense is sexual in nature.
