Fall 2005 Enrollment Report* SUMMARY STATEMENTS

TOTAL ENROLLMENT

◆ Total headcount for fall 2005 is 7035, representing an increase of 33 students over last fall's total headcount of 7002. Total FTE increased by approximately 1.0% to 5989.

NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

- With regard to new undergraduates (freshmen and transfer/re-admits) in fall 2005:
 - o There are 812 new freshmen and 950 transfer/re-admits. These numbers represent decreases from last year of 14 first-time freshmen and 9 transfer/re-admits.
 - o The total SAT for first-time regularly admitted freshmen is 1120 and the average High School Rank
