Preservation Assistance Grants for Smaller Institutions are being offered by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH), Division of Preservation and Access.

The NEH is seeking applications from small and medium-sized institutions such as libraries, museums, historical societies, archival repositories, cultural organizations, town and county records offices, and colleges and universities to improve their ability to preserve and care for their significant historical collections.
