NSF BIO Directorate Eliminates Deadlines for Most Programs

The majority of programs within the Nat onal Science Foundat on's Directorate for Biological Sciences (NSF BIO) will do away with annual deadlines next year, and accept proposals at any t me. Start ng in calendar year 2018, core programs in the Division of Environmental Biology (DEB), the Division of Integrat ve Organismal Systems (IOS), the Division of Molecular and Cellular Biosciences (MCB), and the Research Resources Cluster of the Division of Biological Infrastructure (DBI) will move to a "no-deadline" model. Any upcoming deadlines in calendar year 2017, such as those for the DBI _____ programs, are st II act ve.

While this change af ects most BIO programs, some grants will st II have set deadlines. IOS will support projects for genomic tool development through the Enabling Discovery through Genomic Tools program. DEB will support integrat ve research in the Ecology and Evolut on of Infect ous Diseases (EEID) program and the Dimensions of Biodiversity program. DBI will support the Postdoctoral Fellowship in Biology program. The Macrosystems Biology and Early program will remain under deadlines. Broader

programs like CAREER, MRI, or REU are not af ected by this change.

The National Institute of Food and Agriculture's (NIFA) Community Food Projects (CFP) grants program of ers an opportunity for colleges and universit es to help meet the food needs of low-income individuals in their surrounding communit es. Eligibility is limited to public food program service providers, tribal organizations, or private nonprofitient ties, but applicants are encouraged to enter into partnerships with other organizat ons, including academic inst tut ons. CFP grants can be used to support food init at ves in a number of areas including: food distribut on, community outreach, improving food access, increasing community food self-reliance, developing comprehensive local food access systems, and more.
